
## Flip Flop Fiesta!

**Special Supplies:** Stylus, Graphite Paper/Transfer paper, palette knife, white eraser, toothbrush, small dot stencil, and tape. You will also need your regular painting supplies, paint palette listed below and a tablecloth.

Paint Palette: DecoArt Americana Paint Alizarin Crimson, Antique White, Asphaltum, Bahama Blue, Bleached Sand, Buttermilk, Calypso Blue, Coral Brush, Diox Purple, Hauser Dark Green, Khaki Tan, Lamp Black, Lavender, Light Avocado, Olive Green, Paynes Grey, Primary Yellow, Prussian Blue, Raw Sienna, Sand, Santa Red, Snow White, and Yellow Ochre.



Students are to provide their own 9" x 12" surface. There will lot of prep before class and you will get prep instructions and the line drawing. The complete pattern will be given in class. The class will be 5 hours.

# Sail Away 2023

We are all so excited to be seeing everyone at Sail Away this year. There are a few things we want to remind you of before you arrive.

This year Sail Away will be held in a new location: the Holiday Inn Oceanfront at 6600 Coastal Hwy, Ocean City, MD. (Entrance to the hotel is on 67th street, the convention hall entrance is facing Coastal Hwy on the 66th street side)

- Room rates are \$59 Thursday night, \$119 on Friday and Saturday night and \$59 on Sunday night and each room has 2 queen beds and an Eastern or Southern Ocean view. Check-in is 4 pm and check-out is 11 am.
- You must call 410-524-1600 to make your reservations. Do not make them
  online or you will not get the reduced rate. Be sure to reserve your rooms
  by February 21, 2023 and tell them that you are with Chesapeake Bay Decorative Painters to lock in these rates.
  After February 21 rates go up to their normal prices, so reserve now. You will be charged for one night when you
  make your reservation.
- All rooms have a stove, sink, Keurig machine, and an apartment sized refrigerator with freezer. Some dishes are available in the cabinets. Bring your own breakfast items or purchase breakfast in the restaurant downstairs.

Mason Jar Decorating Contest – Be sure to decorate a mason jar to "capture the light" to win a \$25 gift certificate to a craft store. Bring them to the Thursday night Social or the registration table upstairs by Friday at noon. We'll have them on display at the registration area near the classrooms over the weekend. Everyone will receive one voting ticket in their registration packets and voting will start at 8 AM on Saturday and will close at 4 pm. The winner will be determined by votes from attendees and will be announced at the Banquet on Saturday night. We can't wait to see what you create!

#### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

- No outside food or drink may be consumed in the public areas of the hotel. You may bring your own food, but you must consume it in your room or off site. According to hotel policy, if anyone is found eating/drinking outside food/drink, we will be charged a \$200 fine. Your attention to this requirement is greatly appreciated.
- Water will be provided in the classrooms for consumption, but you may bring your own beverage in an insulated cup. (They can't tell what's in it.)
- There are several eating establishments across the street from the hotel. Dunkin Donuts, Longboard Café, Sweet Frog, and Generals Kitchen. There are several more a short walking distance from the hotel. Please remember to eat the food in your room or at the offsite restaurant itself. Thank you.
- Photos Photos will be taken throughout the weekend. If you do not want your picture to be taken, you must notify Jennifer (jenib@comcast.net) or Joann (joannywheeler@outlook.com).
- Thursday Night Social 6 to 8 pm in the Wine Room across from the Touch of Italy restaurant in the lobby area. Registration packets will be available for you to pick up. Bring your decorated Mason Jars! If you didn't order food on your registration form, the restaurant will be open and you can order there and bring it across the lobby to the social. The same goes for alcoholic beverages! We've got a surprise art activity for you! Judy and Joann are planning it, so it should be great fun.

The classrooms are nice. Everything is on the same floor. The social room is also nice for Thursday night. Anyone can come - with or without a food order. Each of the hotel bedrooms has a mini-kitchen, including a Keurig. Some even have a fireplace. They have nice views of the ocean, also. The hotel has an indoor pool and jacuzzi. There was a miscommunication about breakfast vouchers, though. We will not receive these as part of the room cost, as originally thought. But with a full kitchen in the rooms, Joann suggested can cook our breakfasts there instead.
